He spoke about his work for the Illinois High School Association as a clinician and rules interpreter, an IHSA state finals official, and as a conference official scheduler. Laude discussed challenges for game officials, major rules changes for football, and shared several memorable experiences during his career.

John Thorne, who coached the Tigers of Wheaton Warrenville South/Wheaton Central High School for 22 years once said, "Football is so much like life: you get knocked down, you suffer devastating losses, you make huge mistakes, but you have to get right back up. You have no choice." Sports fans nationwide know Soldier Field as the home of the Chicago Bears. For decades its signature columns provided an iconic backdrop for gridiron matches. Few remember that Soldier Field hosted Billy Graham and Martin Luther King Jr., Judy Garland and Johnny Cash—as well as Grateful Dead ' s final show. Soldier Field captures the dramatic history of Chicago ' s stadium on the lake and will captivate sports fans and historians alike.
