**LOCATING AN UNMARKED CEMETERY**. As mentioned earlier, Christian graves are laid out in a west/east direction. When trying to locate a lost cemetery, it is best to walk in north/south direction in order to pick up a pattern. Usually you will find the graves to be separated by 2-3 feet.

Grave dowsing can be used to verify sites of unmarked graves. Dowsing (divining) rods can be bought or constructed in the following method. I always use a very light material (1/8 aluminum) as this causes less friction on your index fingers. Any type of metal will work old coat hangers, etc.
